Board Fundraising Menu

All FCCRSNC Board Members are required to contribute to the fundraising efforts of the organization. Please select 2 or more items from the menu that you feel comfortable doing within a year.

- Host a party in coordination with the Director of Development where you can talk about the great work that FCCRSNC does. Ideas: cocktail party, dinner party, etc.
- Use crowdfunding to promote online contributions, honor donors publicly, and create excitement.
- Be responsible for purchasing a table or selling 8 tickets to the annual Whiskers ‘n Wags Jubilee fundraiser.
- Make an in-kind donation to FCCRSNC – a computer, building materials, cat care supplies, etc. You can also donate a valuable item like a painting, heirloom, stock, real estate, etc.
- Have a garage sale and donate the proceeds to FCCRSNC.
- Solicit businesses for in-kind donations in coordination with the Director of Development.
- Donate something of value to the annual Whiskers ‘n Wags Jubilee silent or live auction in coordination with the Director of Development.
- If you own a getaway home, rent it out a few times a year and donate the proceeds to FCCRSNC.
- Find out if your employer has a matching gift program. For every dollar you give to FCCRSNC, your employer will match it by a certain amount.
- If you belong to a book club or other group, ask them to “adopt” FCCRSNC for a year as their favorite charity and collect \$10 from each person at each meeting.
- Sell FCCRSNC calendars.
- Write out your holiday cards early, include a short description of FCCRSNC, and hand write a note letting people know what a great organization this is, and to consider it in their end-of-year giving.
- Serve on the committee for one of the larger fundraising events throughout the year (WWJ, Calendar, Annual Birthday Party, etc.)
