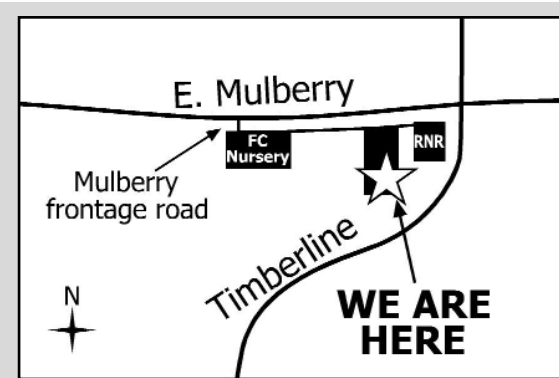

Our cats come to us from many situations:

- Found abandoned or as strays
- Surrendered by their owners
- Transferred from other shelters

Adoption Fees

- Kittens (2-5 mos.) \$150-\$175
 - “Teenage” cats (6-11 mos.) \$100-\$125
 - Young Adult cats (1-5 yrs.) \$75-\$100
 - Adult cats (6+ yrs.) \$50-\$75
 - Working/Barn cats \$30
 - 2-for-1 Mama & Me specials
- Adopt a kitten and take home mama for free!

Special Kneads Club

Cats w/ specific manageable medical or behavior issues are fee waived and come with special incentives and goodies

- Various discounted adoption specials throughout the year (see website)

All adoptable cats/kittens have had:

- ✓ Veterinary exam
- ✓ Spay/neuter procedure
- ✓ Vaccinations ✓ Deworming
- ✓ Feline leukemia testing
- ✓ Microchip identification

Adopter also receives coupons for a discount on Natural Balance pet food at Poudre Pet & Feed Supply and for a FREE local veterinary exam.

- Kibble assistance for low-income pet owners
- Rental of live traps for feral Trap/Neuter/Return

PAL+

Financial Assistance for Spay/Neuter

The Prevent A Litter Plus (PAL+) program assists individuals who cannot afford to spay, neuter, vaccinate or microchip their pets. PAL+ provides spay/neuter for a \$20-\$25 co-pay to approved low-income applicants or those on government assistance. Vaccines are 50% off; microchips are \$15. This program is funded by monetary donations and grants, so assistance is dependent upon available funding.

Kibble Supply

Food Bank for Low-Income Pet Owners

Pet owners experiencing financial hardship and having difficulty affording dog or cat food can pick up a monthly supplement of free food. Food is handed out on a first come, first served basis on two regularly scheduled distribution days each month from Unit 8. This program is made possible through donations, so assistance is dependent upon the availability of donated food.

Donations of food are accepted *anytime*.
